

# Sorting instructions

## Green bin



The Green bin is for recyclable plastic packaging, paper, tetrapaks, cartons, cardboard, and small metal objects. Packaging must be clean to be recyclable. Therefore it's important to empty and rinse food leftovers from the packaging. Unclean packaging should go into the garbage.

### Cardboard



All cardboard boxes, pizza boxes, moving boxes etc.

### Newspapers/magazines



Newspapers, magazines, envelopes, copy paper etc.

### Tetrapacks/cerealboxes



Beverage cartons, cereal boxes, egg trays etc.

### Plastic packaging



All kinds of soft and hard plastic packaging. Bags, film, bottles and containers etc.

### Small metals



Small metal objects. Steel and tin cans, aluminium foil, jar lids etc.

### Not allowed

Unclean packaging  
Toys  
Styrofoam  
Electronics  
CDs and DVDs  
Toothbrushes  
Plastic folders  
Baking sheets  
Pharmaceutical waste  
Packaging from harmful substances

## ATTENTION! NO HARMFUL WASTE

Sharp objects such as knives, glass or needles are not allowed in the Green bin. No infectious waste or other potential harmful waste should go into the Green bin.
